Peter Rowe is currently the Educational Programme Director for the Aga Khan Trust for Culture. The Aga Khan Award for Architecture (AKAA) was established in 1977 to enhance understanding and appreciation of Islamic culture as expressed through architecture. Unique among the major architectural awards, the AKAA not only rewards individual architects for exemplary contemporary work, but also recognizes projects that propose original, replicable solutions that satisfy physical, social, and economic needs. Rowe served on the 2004 AKAA Award Steering committee. For 12 years, Rowe was Dean of the Harvard Design School. Prior to that, he was Director of the School of Architecture at Rice University. Among his research interests are the cultural interpretation and design at both the architectural and urban scales, and the relationship of urban forms to economics and resource conservation.
